ANEWERAFOR At the July meeting of the Board of Directors, the Board voted unanimously to transfer the catalog of Waupun COLLECTIONS CARE Historical Society collection from PastPerfect to a new system called "CatalogIt" which offers a new format that is easier to enter objects, track their location, and search the records. This move will hopefully be more conducive for volunteers who want to learn the ins and outs of data entry, record keeping, and object tracking. With objects properly cataloged, we can find Waupun's stories faster and share them more readily with the public. Waupun at one time had all our holdings available online, but due to a lack of consistency in data entry, searching for something was difficult. Executive Director Kyle Clark has been hard at work scanning every document, photograph, and photographing every object. We have over 20,000 items currently documented and ready for entry. If you are interested in learning some basic tasks in data entry, the Museum and future generations would be grateful for your time.



A RECIPE FROM THE ARCHIVE

The Waupun Heritage Museum holds several cookbooks from long ago featuring recipes from families in Waupun. We thought we'd feature one here for you to try at home! The following recipe appears in the 1909 Waupun Cook Book:

"L<u>emon Sandwiche</u>s

Mash the yolks of three hard boiled eggs, add two ounces of butter, one-fourth teaspoonful of salt, a dash of cayenne, one teaspoonful of chopped parsley, grated rind of one lemon; mix these well together into a paste, with three tablespoonfuls of lemon juice. Spread upon thin slices of whole wheat bread." ||
